As part of your son/daughter's GCSE PE course they are required to complete a practical assessment which is worth up to 40% of their overall GCSE PE grade. To support pupils through this practical assessment and further develop their overall grade we have linked with 'The wall in the hall' climbing centre in Tiverton and are running a 6 week series of climbing sessions. In addition to raising the pupils' GCSE PE grade these sessions also have the added benefit of students working towards a NICAS climbing qualification:
