History London Trip – ‘Crime and Punishment’ November 2021

Thank you for signing your child up to for our History “Crime and Punishment” trip to London. We are excited to be heading off this trip at the end of next week. Thank you also to your children who have completed our food preference questionnaire and given us their room share preferences. We are now writing about some final details:

Itinerary:

Wednesday 10th November:

- Covid lateral flow test in school. In the event of a positive test your child will not be able to travel, and a full refund will be issued.

Thursday 11th November:

- Pupils will not have to wear uniform on this day.
- By 8:50am – Drop travel bag/small case in the OP store.
- 8:50am – 3:30pm – Lessons as normal
- 3:40pm – Collect travel bag/small case from OP store and drop off school bag then meet in the Dining Hall.
- 4:00pm – Coach departs.
- tbc - Services meal stop **pupils should bring a packed meal or money for food at the services.**
- 8:00pm – Arrive at our accommodation (Safestay, Elephant and Castle, London).

Friday 12th November:

- All food provided.
- Tower Bridge experience.
- Tower of London.
- ‘Clink’ prison museum.
- London Dungeons
- ‘Jack the Ripper’ guided walk.

Saturday 13th November:

- All food provided.
- ‘Westminster crime and policing’ guided walk.
- Covent Garden for lunch.
- Journey home.

- Approximately 8:00pm - Pick up from school. Pupils will phone parent/guardian with a precise arrival time during the journey home.

Packing advice:

- Don't pack too much: we are only away for 2 nights!
- Small rucksack/day bag: to carry lunch and essentials.
- Raincoat – vital as we will be outside in the British weather a lot.
- Shoes that you are happy to walk in – there is plenty of walking planned.
- Packed evening meal or money for service meal (or both!) – for Thursday evening.

Medical form / covid requirements:
