



Dear Parents/Guardians

As part of the Key Stage 3 History course, we would like to provide students with an opportunity to participate in a series of workshops on the English Civil War which are run by 'Swords and Spindles Living History', formerly the Outreach Education team based at Torrington 1646. These workshops will involve various characters from the Civil War and will enrich students' understanding of this period in history. Students will participate in five separate workshops which will be on Tuesday 17th September for the R band and Wednesday 18th September 2019 for the B band.
